### Romans 9:24-33

Passages to read;

Isaiah 1:9, 8:11-15, 10:22-23, 28:14-22; Daniel 2:31-45; Hosea 2  
Matthew 21:42-42; Mark 12:10-11; Luke 20:17-18; Acts 4:8-12;  
Romans 9; Philippians 3:12-14; 2 Timothy 2:22; 1 Peter 2:4-10

1. Paul has been setting forth the absolute sovereignty of God in freely choosing whom He desires for salvation in 9:1-23. What does Paul say in Romans 9:24 that confirms this?

2. What is Paul saying about the Gentiles from the quotations from Hosea? What is he saying about the Jews? What relationship exists between Israel and the Church?

3. How do the verses from Isaiah quoted in vv. 27-29, support Paul's overall argument of chapter 9?

4. Explain how Gentiles who were not pursuing righteousness have obtained it.

5. Paul tells us in verse 31 that Israel did not obtain the righteousness that they sought. What are Paul's reasons for why they did not achieve their goal?
